It is a graduation requirement for all CSU campuses.</p> <p>AP Eligibility: AP US History passing exam scores would meet the Constitution requirement providing that the exam name, exam score and the units of credit awarded by the regionally-accredited college or university were posted on the official transcript from that college or university. Regulations require that we see a course listed on the official transcript.
